

These block should measure 6 inches when finished.

Cutting Pieces

- 1 12 1/2 inch square white background
- 1 8 inch circle feature fabric


Starting with the 12 1/2 " square fold in half both ways and press. Set aside Secondly take the 8 " circle and fold into fourths the same as the square. Press Open both pieces lay the circle on top of the square right sides of fabric up,

Aligning the creases together, pin in place.

Stitch on top of the circle with any design your machine might have, zigzags, blanket, flowers.

Cut this patch into the four pieces on the pressed lines.

Now you have 4 quarter circles for the 1 in 4 Drunkard Path.
