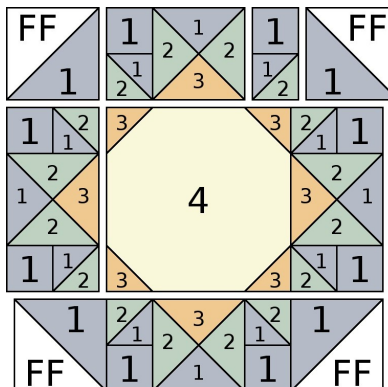
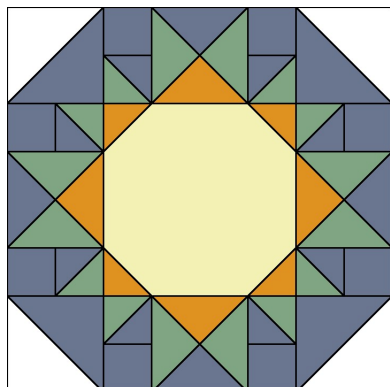


WHEEL OF FORTUNE
12½" unfinished (12" finished)



We have given you a focus fabric (FF) to put in the four corners of Wheel of Fortune. Choose four other fabrics to complete this block. You'll get the illusion of a circle without the trouble of sewing curves.

Cut

Focus Fabric

2 – 3⅞" squares, cut diagonally once

Fabric 1

2 – 3⅞" squares (match with FF for half-square triangles)

4 – 2⅜" squares, cut diagonally once

8 – 2" squares

Fabric 2

4 – 2⅜" squares, cut diagonally once

2 – 4¾" squares, cut diagonally twice

Fabric 3

1 – 4¾" squares, cut diagonally twice

4 – 2" squares

Fabric 4

1 – 6½" square

Layer FF squares, right sides together, with Fabric 1 squares. Draw a line diagonally on the square and sew ¼" on either side of the line. Cut the square apart on the line. (You will get two half-square units from each square. Make all the half-square triangle units this way.)

For the center of the block, Lay 2" squares on each of the corners. Draw a line diagonally on each small square. Sew on the line. Fold the triangle over. This should "nip" the corner of the 6½" center square.

Follow the color-by-number diagram and sew the pieces together. Always start with the smallest pieces first. Sew the sides onto the center square. Sew the top and bottom rows onto the center row.
