## Camp Wannamakeablankie Blocks 2013

The blocks in the finished quilt are 9", so will be 9-1/2" with seam allowances. Use only very pure white fabric and bright Husker red. Since the pattern is easy and fast to make, please make one white block <u>and</u> one red block. Sew extra blocks to put into a block drawing.

For the white block - white fabric: Cut 2 rectangles 3-1/2" X 9-1/2". Cut 1 square 3-1/2" X 3-1/2". Cut 1 square 4" X 4". Red fabric: cut 1 square 4" X 4".

Draw a line on the diagonal of the 4" white square. Lay right sides together with the red 4" square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut along the line. Press seam toward the red. Trim the 2 blocks to 3-1/2" X 3-1/2" with the seam exactly in the center of the diagonal. Stitch the two squares formed on either side of the white 3-1/2" square as shown in the diagram. Add the 9-1/2" rectangles to each side.

Reverse colors to make a red block.
