

Camp Wannamakeablankie Blocks 2013

The blocks in the finished quilt are 9", so will be 9-1/2" with seam allowances. Use only very pure white fabric and bright Husker red. Since the pattern is easy and fast to make, please make one white block and one red block. Sew extra blocks to put into a block drawing.

For the white block - white fabric: Cut 2 rectangles 3-1/2" X 9-1/2". Cut 1 square 3-1/2" X 3-1/2". Cut 1 square 4" X 4". Red fabric: cut 1 square 4" X 4".

Draw a line on the diagonal of the 4" white square. Lay right sides together with the red 4" square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut along the line. Press seam toward the red. Trim the 2 blocks to 3-1/2" X 3-1/2" with the seam exactly in the center of the diagonal. Stitch the two squares formed on either side of the white 3-1/2" square as shown in the diagram. Add the 9-1/2" rectangles to each side.

Reverse colors to make a red block.
