

PAPER DOLL CRAYON QUILT SUPPLY LIST

Box of good quality crayons with lots of colors

Number 2 pencil, sharpened

Permanent fine line black marker, do not use a Sharpie, (I will have available for purchase my favorite brand)

Few sheets of tracing paper

Freezer paper and wax paper, you may want to share with a pal as you will not be using the entire rolls yourself

Light colored cotton, bring at least one yard, or more if you are a fast worker, pre wash and if you use a dryer, DO NOT USE DRYER SHEETS. If you plan on adding fabric to your crayoned images bring lots of pieces at least $\frac{1}{4}$ yard in size.

Roll of blue painters tape or masking tape

Pattern: lots of choice here, crayon coloring books are a good source, quilt patterns, especially applique' ones, Pictures out of magazines or whatever you like. Avoid very small images, under 1". I will have several patterns available for purchase

If you want to make the girl sweeping the floor or the boy playing marbles, I will have those full size patterns available

Regular sewing supplies, paper and fabric scissors, pins

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard light weight fusible web such as steam a seam or heat n bond

Optional: light box, individual iron, embroidery thread in your Choice of color, embroidery needle and hoop.

NO SEWING MACHINES REQUIRED FOR THIS CLASS

This workshop is for beginners to advanced quilters and everyone in between. I will provide each student with a free practice kit and a booklet for you to take home.
