

Supply List for String Piecing Reimagined Class

Sewing Machine that can zigzag, with normal attachments; but include the following:

Cording or Piping Foot (use a zipper foot if you must)

Darning or Free-Motion Foot

Extension cord and/or power strip (unless these are provided for us)

Personal iron and ironing mats if possible

Personal rotary cutter, mat, rulers if space allows

Thread to blend with the various colors you use – medium grey or beige

Scissors – both paper and fabric

Pencils for marking

Glue Stick

Lightweight Stabilizer – 1 yard (i.e., Pattern Ease)

Pattern for the project of your choice (will be available at class)

Fabric: 2.5” strips of a variety of solid colors for the arcs. These can be the same colors I used or different, depending on your preferences.

Helix Background: 1 yard gray, cut in half and stitched together (21” x 72”); Piping: 1/3 yard darker grey 8.5 yards of 3/16” cording

Arcs Background and Piping: 1 ¼ yard of dark purple or navy; 12 yards of 3/16” cording

Hearts Background: 2/3 yard white; piping 1/3 yard of red; 6 yards of 3/16” cording

Kits and/or Patterns will be available for purchase at the class. The kits include the pattern and everything below the line.

Helix: Kit \$71 (pattern only: \$26)

Arcs: Kit \$80 (pattern only: \$25)

Hearts: Kit \$57 (pattern only: \$20)

NOTE: I am transitioning from hand-dyed strips to regular cotton strips in these kits.
